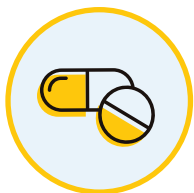
BHG data shows that **patient risk factors are reduced by 40%** and **use scores are reduced by 53%** after 3 months of treatment. Risk factors and **protective factors improve for up to 5 years** following the start of treatment.

Whole-patient approach

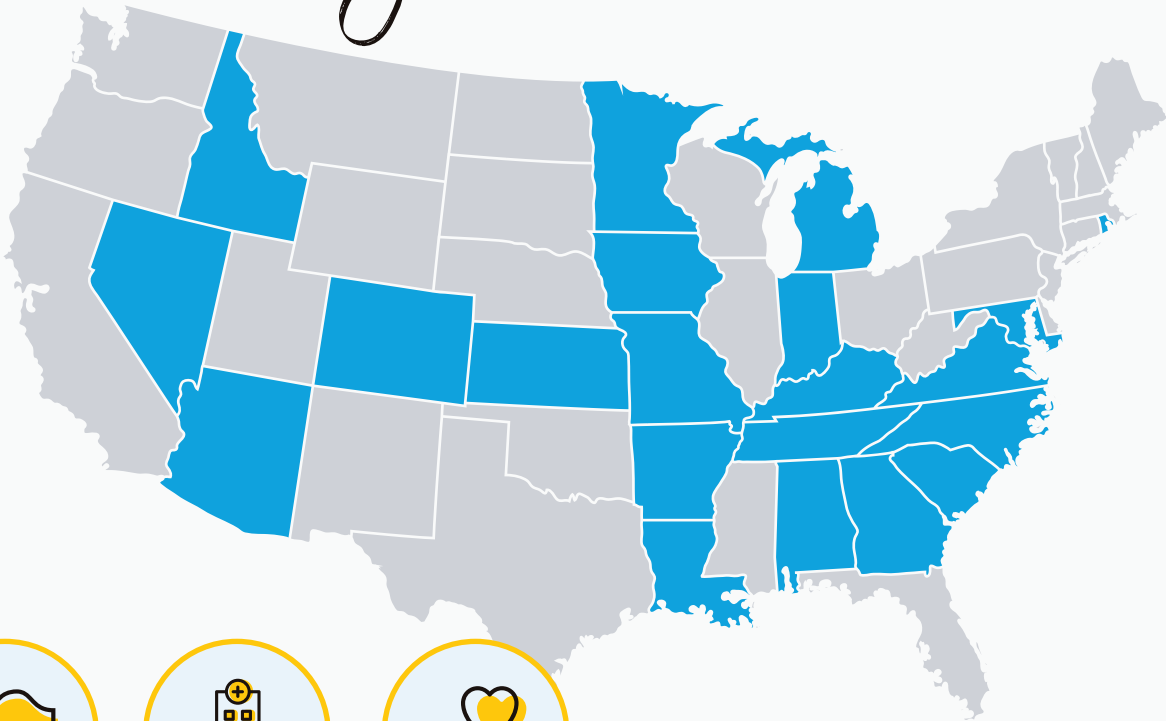
